Call to Tuftonboro Artists

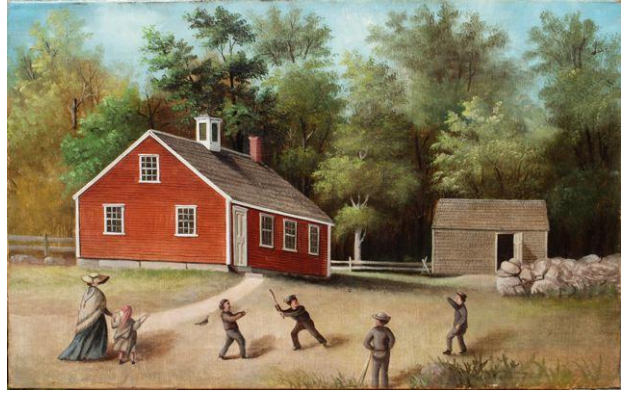
