The Governor Wentworth Arts Council is pleased to present two exhibits of local artists in Wolfeboro. See "Symmetry & Nature" by Robin Cornwell at the Wolfeboro branch of Meredith Village Savings Bank through June 25th. Her new paper cut designs are made using a traditional Polish paper cutting method called Wycinanki. Wycinanki was historically used by Polish peasants to decorate their homes. In these works Robin uses symmetry to convey themes of nature and nurture with repeating elements of the hands, heart, and trees. Taking inspiration from her walks in nature and from teaching methods that have inspired decades of young artists at Kingswood Regional Middle School, Robin's work is brimming with wonderful care and craftsmanship.
